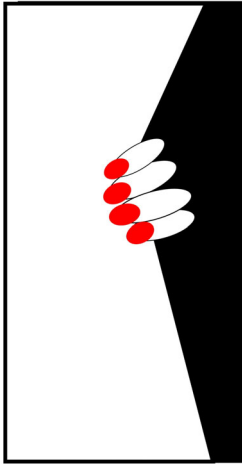


THE THIRD ACT
